



ADMISSION POLICY

Notice of Non-Discriminatory Policy as to Students

The elementary and secondary schools of the Diocese of Santa Rosa, CA, admit students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the schools. They do not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admission policies, scholarship and loan programs, athletic and other school administered programs.

PLEASE READ BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORMS

The State of California requires a child to be 5 years old by September 1, 2018 in order to enter a regular Kindergarten class. St. Mary's uses this date as a guideline. St. Mary's understands that there are many indicators of readiness besides the date of birth. A Developmental Readiness Screening will be arranged for all Kindergarten applicants.

IMPORTANT: The following documents must be submitted when your child has applied or has been accepted into the school.

1. **Application Fee:** A non-refundable application fee of \$25.00 per applicant. This fee covers the processing of applications, mailings and readiness testing.
2. **Birth Certificate:** Please provide a copy of the certificate.
3. **Baptismal/First Communion Certificates:** Please provide a copy of these certificates if applicable.
4. **Verification of Immunizations:** **A child may not attend school without the following on file:** Medical records which prove that your child has had the required immunizations for school entry. Incoming Kindergartners and 1st Graders are also required to have a health check-up before school entry. The check-up must be sometime within 18 months of entry into 1st grade. This is mandated by the State of California Child Health and Disability Prevention Program. Parents must submit a "Report of Health Examination for School Entry" (PM 171A). A completed PM 171A is due no later than August 25, 2018.
5. **Transfer students in Grades 1st through 8th must include a copy of current report card and test scores.**

PARENT'S GUIDE TO IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS
For Children Entering School or Child Care in California

This is what is needed at the time application is made to the school.

You will need to provide a copy of your child's *verified immunization record* with the application. It must show the date (month/day/year) your child was given each required shot.

IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL

If your child's record is missing some doses, please contact your doctor or clinic soon to schedule an appointment for when these doses will be due. **Important: State Law requires the school to refuse attendance to children until all requirements have been met.**

Your child may be exempted for a medical condition by submitting a written statement from a licensed physician.

CHECK UP REQUIREMENT FOR INCOMING KINDERGARTENERS AND 1ST GRADERS

Another requirement is that your child has a *health checkup* before school entry. The checkup must be sometime within 18 months of entry into 1st grade. Parents must submit "Report of Health Examination for School Entry" (PM 171A). This is mandated by the State of California Child Health and Disability Prevention Program. The school requires that this form be completed by your child's physician or health clinic and be on file in our school office by August 25, 2018. This is mandatory for all incoming Kindergartners and new enrolling first graders.

REQUIREMENT FOR INCOMING 7TH GRADE STUDENTS

All students going into 7th grade must have proof of having had the Tdap booster shot before starting school.
